Pearl City resident Sharon Ige loves being a part of the Pearl City Lions Club and enjoys seeing all the benefits the group brings for her community.

She assists the club in everything from painting to picking up rubbish, and giving out stickers after vision and hearing screenings.

Ige, who lost her vision 15 years ago, sought out her local Lions Club after learning how good the organization was to the blind community. They are, in fact, called the Knights of the Blind.

The Knights of the Blind

program is something close to Ige's heart, and since joining Pearl City Lions Club four years ago, she has been active in promoting sight programs for preventable blindness.

One of her first Lions Club volunteer opportunities came in the form of painting the large wall by the old Aiea Library.

"I wanted to help, but some of my fellow Lions, I swear they were painting after me," she humorously said. "I just do what I can; I don't want to stand around. If I'm there, my time is valuable, too, and I want to make sure I'm
